GOALS GONE WRONG

Our readings this weekend can be described as "Goals Gone Wrong." The authors describe what are the proper means of achieving a worthwhile positive goal by using the examples of wrong goals that are vain or selfish or misdirected. As Christians, God provides us with the grace and inspiration to truly be "beautiful" and "profitable" by recog-

nizing not only my own self-worth but most importantly how my actions affect others. My original dignity created by God has been restored by the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, as St. Paul reminds us. What better person historically to remind us of what God has done and continues to do for us as St. Paul; he, who originally persecuted and imprisoned the early Christians. 


